Can I use a DSU on a Frame Relay circuit?

Q: Can I use a DSU on a Frame Relay circuit?

A: A DSU can be used for any 56k or 64k DDS line, including lines provisioned for Frame Relay. However, the DSU is not a Frame Relay Access Device (FRAD) and must therefore be connected to a FRAD (i.e., router) before the Frame Relay service can be established.

The ADTRAN Express 5210 can be used to terminate a 56k or 64k Frame Relay circuit and has FRAD functionality.
