
An ISDN line provides two 64,000 bps B channels that can be used simultaneously for error free data transmission up to 128,000 bps without compression.

To maximize data transmission, the Express XRT supports Stac® $LZS^{\mathbb{M}}$ compression with throughput up to 230,400 bps per the PPP standard. The Express XRT compression is also compatible with Ascend® compression techniques.

The Express XRT can support up to two analog devices such as your telephone, FAX machine, or analog modem in addition to the computer connection for data transmissions. Over one ISDN phone line, you can talk on the phone and transmit data from your computer simultaneously.

When transmitting data at maximum throughput over both B channels using multilink PPP, the Express XRT automatically detects calls on the analog ports. Upon detection, the Express XRT adjusts the speed of the data call to 64,000 bps using one B channel and accepts the analog/voice call on the other B channel. Upon completion of the analog/voice call, the Express XRT automatically resumes data transfer over both channels.
